

Handgun Safety Clinic

Due to the increasing number of Union County residents purchasing handguns, the Union County Anti-Drug Coalition is partnering with both local law enforcement agencies to provide an 8 hour **Handgun Safety Course**. The course will include 4 hours of class time and 4 hours of range practice for \$25.00. These classes will be taught by certified firearm instructors. The class will cover civil liability, cleaning and loading your weapon, legal responsibilities, and scenario based instruction on when to use or NOT use a handgun. After successful completion of the 4 hour class, you will then register for your 4 hours of instruction at a firing range. You must be legally able to possess a firearm and you **MUST** register (name and type of weapon) in advance for the class. You will need you bring your **UNLOADED** weapon to class. Classes are limited to 20 participants and will be held on the following dates: September 9th, 8:00a.m. – 12:00p.m. September 9th, 1:00p.m.-5:00p.m. September 10th, 8:00a.m. – 12:00p.m. Weekend classes will be made available if needed.
